ORDINANCE #86

AN ORDINANCE TO ELIMANATE THE RIDING OF ANY BICYCLE, ROLLER BOARD, SCOOTER, OR OTHER MANUALLY PROPELLED DEVICE IN AN UNSAFE OR DESTRUCTIVE MANNER ON THE SIDEWALKS AND RAMPS OF THE DESIGNATED AREA.

THE VILLAGE OF SPRINPORT ORDAINS:

Section I. <u>BUSINESS DISTRICT.</u>

The riding of bicycles, roller boards, or any manually propelled type of conveyance on the downtown sidewalks and ramps of the Village of Springport is prohibited.

Section A: No person shall ride a bicycle, roller board, scooter, or any other type of manually propelled device on any sidewalk or crosswalk in the down town area in an unsafe or destructive manner. This area is defined as; E. Main St. from the East Alley located next to 206 E. Main St., to the East corner of M-99 at Maple St. This includes both sides of the street.

Section II. MOTORIZED SKATEBOARDS

No person shall ride a MOTORIZED SKATEBOARD on any sidewalk or street of the Village of Springport in an unsafe or destructive manner.

Section III.	PENALTY.
	Violators of this ordinance will be penalized as follows:
	In the case of a juvenile (17 years or under):
	1 st Offense: Verbal warning accompanied with an acknowledgement form, which will be given to the parent or legal guardian.
	1st Repeat Offense: \$50.00 plus costs and other sanctions.
	2 nd Repeat Offense: \$100.00 plus costs and other sanctions.
	Any subsequent repeat offenses by a minor: \$250.00 plus costs and other sanctions.
	In the case of an adult (18 years or older):
	1st Offense: \$50.00 plus costs and other sanctions.
	1st Repeat Offense: \$100.00 plus costs and other sanctions.
	2 nd Repeat Offense and Any subsequent repeat offenses: \$250.00 plus costs and other sanctions.
Section IV.	This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication. EFFECTIVE DATE: day of,2007
Section. V.	Enactment of this ordinance rescinds and replaces any and all ordinances previously numbered eighty-six (86) in the Springport Village Code of Ordinances.
